Full-time status at Columbia College Chicago is 12 through 16 credits per semester. All degree-seeking undergraduate students are required to complete Global Awareness (3 credits), U.S. Pluralism (3 credits), Writing Intensive (3 credits), and upper division (2000-level or higher) LAS (6 credits) courses.

\*This planning tool is calculated assuming the following: you will transfer in 60 total credits, you have completed all of your Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) Core requirements, and you will not transfer in any major requirements. Full-time status at Columbia College Chicago is 12 through 16 credits per semester. All degree-seeking undergraduate students are required to complete Global Awareness (3 credits), U.S. Pluralism (3 credits), Writing Intensive (3 credits), and upper division (2000-level or higher) LAS (6 credits) courses. Except for Writing Intensive, these requirements may be met in transfer.

Special notes for transfer students: Students wishing to pursue the BFA program must apply in the Fashion Studies Department.

Due to the sequential nature of the BFA in Fashion Design, 6 semesters are required at Columbia College Chicago to complete this program. Some transfer students may require less than 6 semesters if they are transferring in applicable coursework in Fashion Design. Columbia also offers a BA degree in Fashion Design as an alternative option for transfer students who are looking to graduate sooner.
