12 credits required for MA students. 18 credits required for non-MA students. Grade of B or better required in all courses. CGPA of 3.0 or better required.

The Graduate Laban Certificate in Movement Analysis program supports the core objectives of the Department of Dance/Movement Therapy and Counseling with which it is affiliated. The student learning outcomes include:

- Analyze, evaluate, and apply knowledge of functional, expressive, communicative and developmental movement of the human body.
- Understand and embody the elements of Laban Movement Analysis.
- Demonstrate integrated learning in the application and evaluation of techniques for observing and analyzing nonverbal communication.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the intersection between personal movement repertoire, professional role and cultural factors.

Each outcome will be accomplished through engaging course material and projects, all of which address kinesthetic, analytic and theoretical competencies in an integrated manner.
