## ART BFA FINE ARTS

86 credits are required to complete this major. A grade of "C" or better is required in all major coursework. A minimum GPA of 3.0 or better is required in the major. Upon successful completion of this program, students will be able to: 1. Synthesize the appropriate knowledge, skills, materials, technical processes, research methods, and theories, and apply these to the making of individual and collaborative work. 2. Analyze, describe, interpret, contextualize, and constructively critique one's own work and the work of others. 3. Communicate ideas with confidence with relevance to socio-historical perspectives and in the context of art and design history and theory as it applies to the concepts, issues and practices of our times. 4. Present in multiple contexts, such as through the preparation of portfolios and exhibitions, a concise, cohesive, critically edited body of work based on contemporary practices and historical precedents. Additional notes: History of Art I and II DO NOT count toward the LAS Core. If you are completing the Art History Minor, History of Art I and II (22-1101/22-1102) and Twentieth Century Art Theory (22-3110) will double count for the minor. No other classes can double count for both the major and the minor.
