Theatre: Design BFA

Upon successful completion of this program, students will: •Demonstrate and articulate a sophisticated understanding of how design works as a collaborative process that requires close co-operation between the designers, the director, technical team and performers on a theatrical production. •Demonstrate familiarity with all three design disciplines (costume, lighting or scenic design). •Demonstrate a fluent knowledge of technical theatre and theatrical drawing; including, rendering, and drafting.
•Articulate knowledge of art and theatre history and dramatic theory. •Completed a professional-ready portfolio of work that can be used to seek admission to graduate school, or to seek work in the professional theatre. •Successfully complete a capstone experience consisting of either a fully supported design opportunity or a professional internship.

A grade of "C" or better is required in all major coursework. A gpa of 3.0 or better is required in the major for BFA candidates. 80 credits are required to complete the major. BFA candidates must apply in the Theatre Department.
