42 credits required. Grade of "C" or better required in all major courses. Upon successful completion of this program, students will be able to: 1. Describe, analyze, and interpret visual and material works of art and design within social, historical and theoretical contexts. 2. Research, conceptualize, and fabricate art and design projects from inception to completion. 3. Employ two and three-dimensional design principles to communicate visual ideas using drawing, photography, and other techniques. 4. Apply the appropriate knowledge, skills, materials, technical processes, research methodologies and critical thinking to produce works across multiple art and design disciplines. Additional Notes: History of Art I and II DO NOT count toward the LAS Core. If you are completing the Art History Minor, History of Art I and II (22-1101/22-1102) and Twentieth Century Art Theory (22-3110) will double count for the minor. No other classes can double count for both the major and the minor.
