42 credits required. Grade of "C" or better required in all major courses. Upon successful completion of this program, students will be able to: 1. Practice effective research skills, including evaluating research sources, using electronic databases and primary source archives. 4. Create projects that engage with art history and visual culture through innovative formats that involve collaborative and interdisciplinary processes. 5. Write and present original scholarship that is appropriate for submission for publication or as a writing sample in applications to graduate programs, internships, fellowships, and jobs in the field.
