Theatre BA 2012

41 credits required. Grade of C or better required in all major courses. Upon successful completion of this program, students will: 1. Demonstrate an applicable approach to acting. 2. Articulate, in verbal and written form, a basic but applicable knowledge of theatre design. 3. Articulate, in verbal and written form, a rudimentary overview of theatre history and the analysis of plays. 4. Demonstrate an applied understanding of how to market themselves (and, in essence, their theatrical skills and/or knowledge) in the professional marketplace. 5. Articulate a comprehensive understanding of the creation, planning, mounting, and promotion of a theatrical production.

All Theatre majors are required to take the Foundation sequence, -OR- you may take the Alternate sequence with Theatre Faculty Advisor assistance.
