10 credits required. Grade of "B" or better required in all courses. CGPA of 3.0 required.

The Movement Pattern Analysis Certificate (MPAC) program is multi-modal education for body and mind. Coursework is delivered in a small group setting by qualified Movement Pattern Analysis consultants. Individual tutorials round out the educational process by providing personal guidance in curriculum areas such as movement observation and analysis, profile interpretation, and consultative strategies with individuals and groups. Student learning outcomes include the following:

- Knowledge and application of theories, methods and techniques in the practice of Movement Pattern Analysis (MPA) counseling.
- Knowledge of the human body and how its systems affect functional, expressive, communicative, and developmental aspects of movement.
- Knowledge and application of techniques for observing, assessing and researching verbal and non-verbal communication in Movement Pattern Analysis counseling.
- Development of the reflective use of self in understanding decision-making processes and ethical counseling and relationship.

At conclusion, students will complete a team building project in the community applying the principles of Movement Pattern Analysis to select members of the team, place them appropriately, offer career guidance to managers, develop managerial talent and form an executive team.

Mvmnt Pattern Analysis

This course is required of all students. If taken previously as part of the MA or GL-CMA programs, this requirement is considered fulfilled.
