- The maximum number of credits that can be applied to the Cinema Art + Science BFA is 15 credit hours.
- \*Based on qualifications, students who are approved to waive Cinema Notebooks/Cinema Image & Process will be required to take either Production: Fact and Fiction or Production: The Cinematic Essay.

*\*Semesters to degree completion are calculated assuming 60 total credits in transfer with all [Liberal Arts & Sciences Core](#) requirements complete and no major requirements transferred in. Students may lessen the length of time to degree completion by transferring in applicable major courses. Please see [Transferology.com](http://Transferology.com) for information on individual course equivalencies. Full-time status at Columbia College Chicago is 12-16 credits per term. All degree-seeking undergraduate students are required to complete Global Awareness (3 credits), U.S. Pluralism (3 credits), Writing Intensive (3 credits), and upper division (2000 level or higher) LAS core courses (6 credits). Except for Writing Intensive, these requirements may be met in transfer.*
