LITERATURE COURSES 4 SECTIONS REQUIRED; 12 CREDITS

Six of the twelve required literature credits must come from Poetry Literature courses with one course each focused on Pre-20th Century and 20th/21st Century Poets. Courses fulfilling these period distribution requirements vary per semester; students and advisors should refer to the course flyer distributed prior to registration for information about which courses fulfill literary period requirements in a given semester. Six additional credits must come from Humanities Literature (HL) courses of any period or topic other than Intro to Literature.

WRITING ELECTIVES 2 SECTIONS REQUIRED; 6-7 CREDITS

Options for writing elective credit include Poetry Workshop: Performance; Literary Magazine Editing: *Columbia Poetry Review* & *Court Green*; Literary Magazine Production: *Columbia Poetry Review* & *Court Green*; an additional Craft Seminar; Careers in Writing; Writing for New Media; Writing for the Workplace; Writing Comedy; Journal Writing; Writing Memoir; Reviewing the Arts; or, Introduction to Writing Satire & Parody.
