The Undergraduate Research Mentorship Initiative (URMI) connects talented students with junior standing and at least a 3.0 GPA who are interested in conducting academic research with faculty members involved in scholarly projects in their areas of expertise. Students who participate in an URMI project can earn a maximum of 3 credits. Honors URMI courses can also be taken for up to 3 credit hours toward the Honors Program requirement (3.5 GPA required). Complete proposals for URMI projects will include a faculty proposal and cover sheet, a student proposal (see description below), and this form.
